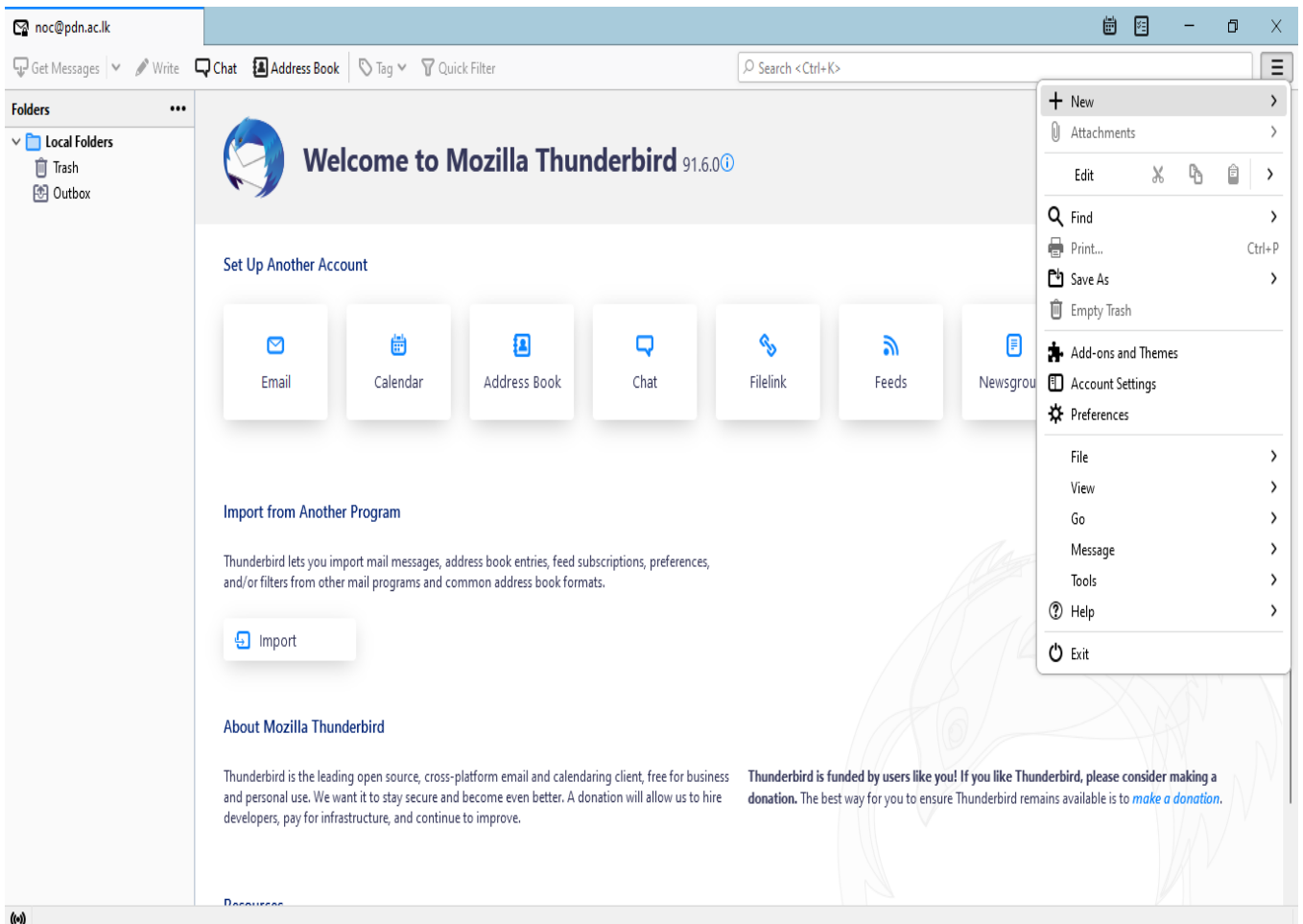
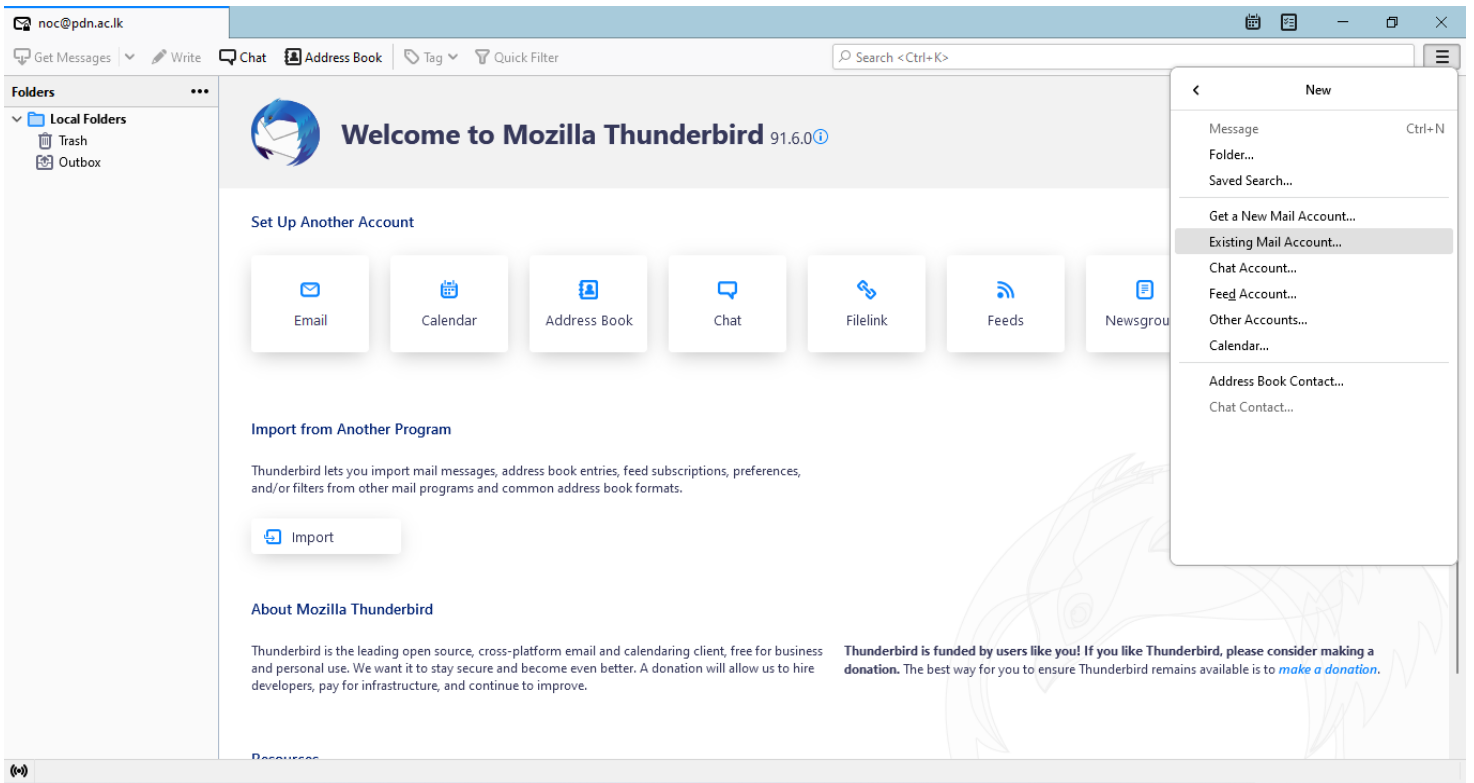


Setting up Mozilla Thunderbird as the mail client for PDN mail delivery

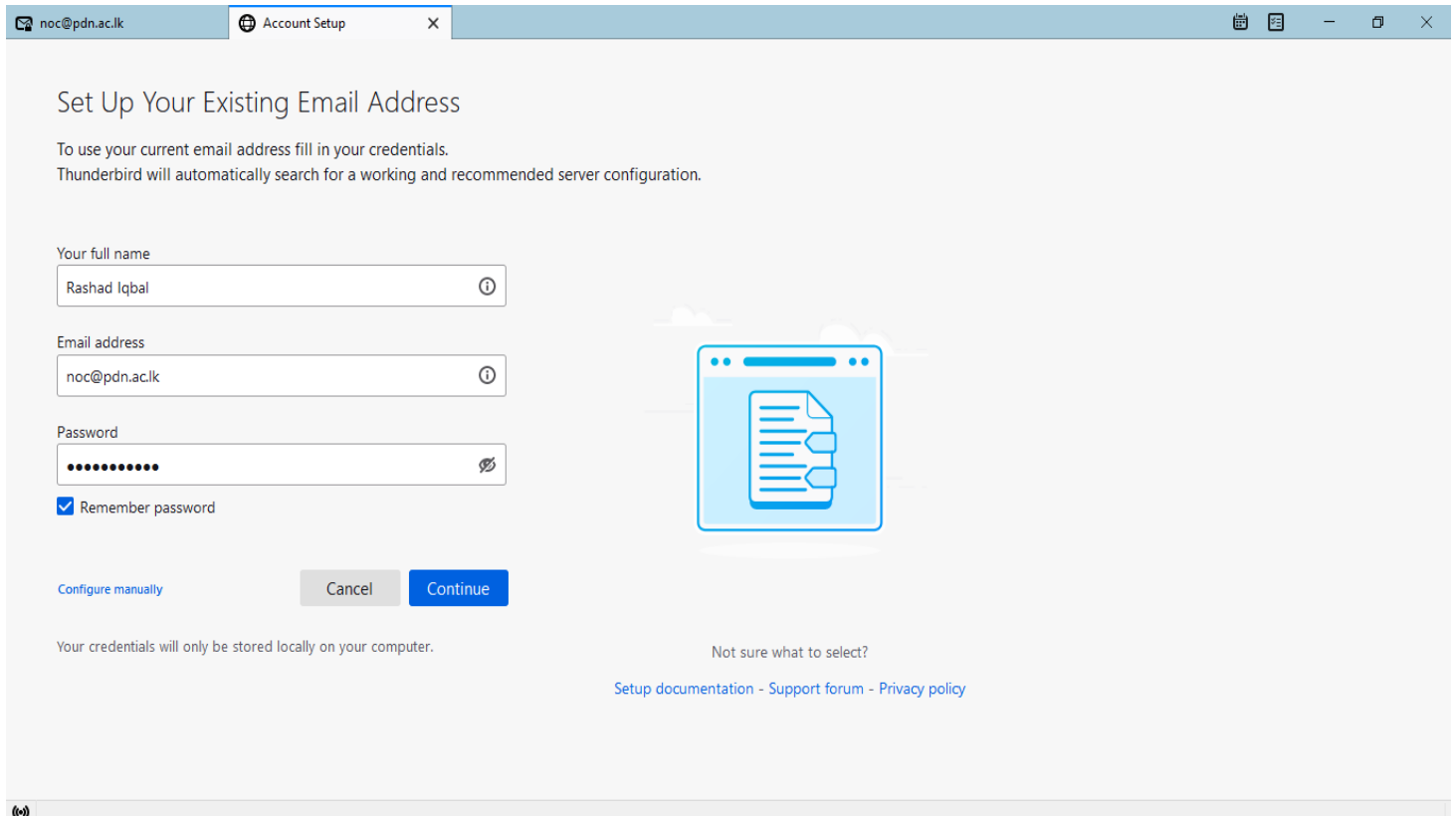
1. Download Mozilla Thunderbird from the following webpage:

 2. Once you have installed the application, please follow the following instructions to setup Mozilla Thunderbird as the mail client for PDN mail delivery.
- Select “New”



- Select “Existing Mail Account”



- Enter your PDN address and the password and select configure manually to setup the incoming outgoing server configurations
