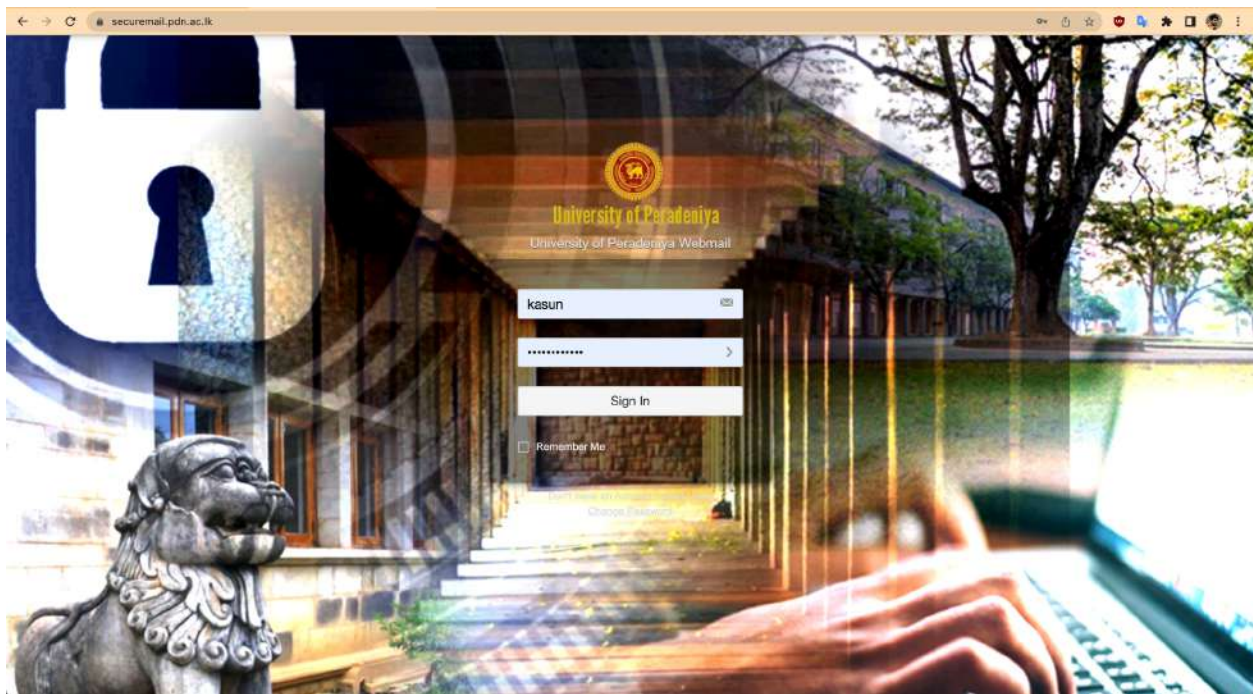
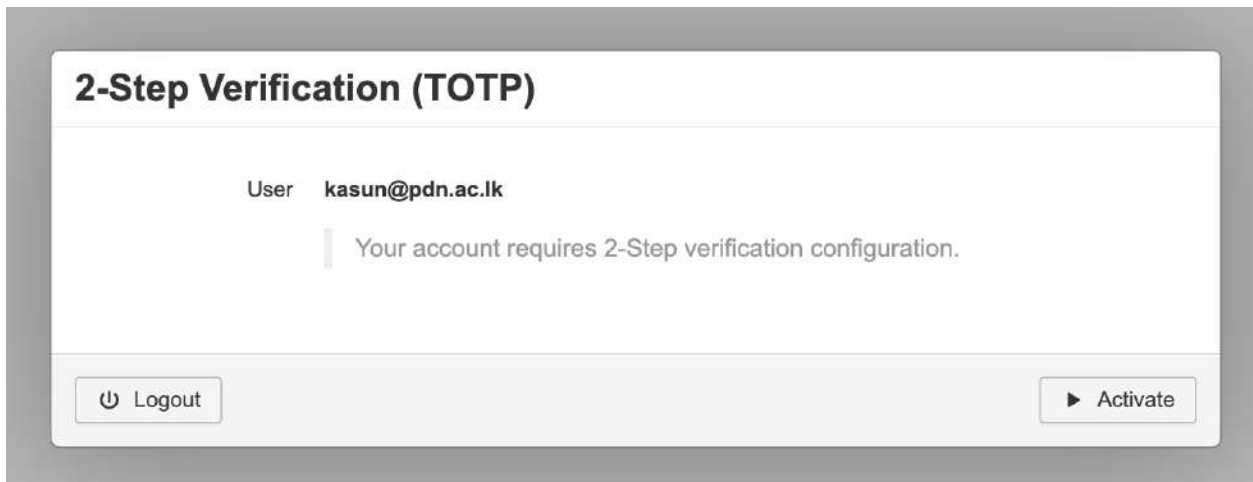


1. Goto securemail.pdn.ac.lk

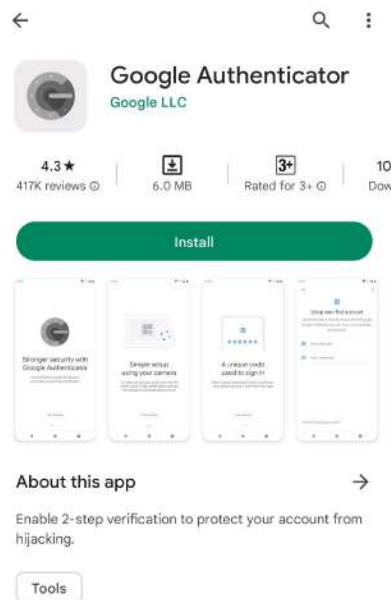


2. Sign in with your PDN Username and Password.

3. You will be prompted to activate two-factor authentication. Click Activate.



- Download Google Authenticator app for your smartphone.



- Scan the QR code from Google Authenticator app or Enter secret code manually. Then add the Account.
- Save the backup codes somewhere safe and accessible only by you in case of emergency. If you can't receive codes via Google Authenticator you can use backup codes to sign in. After you've used a backup code to sign in, it will become inactive. You will get a total of 9 backup codes.
- After adding your PDN account to Google Authenticator click test.


2-Step Verification (TOTP)




8. Enter the Authentication code displaying in Google Authenticator and click Test.



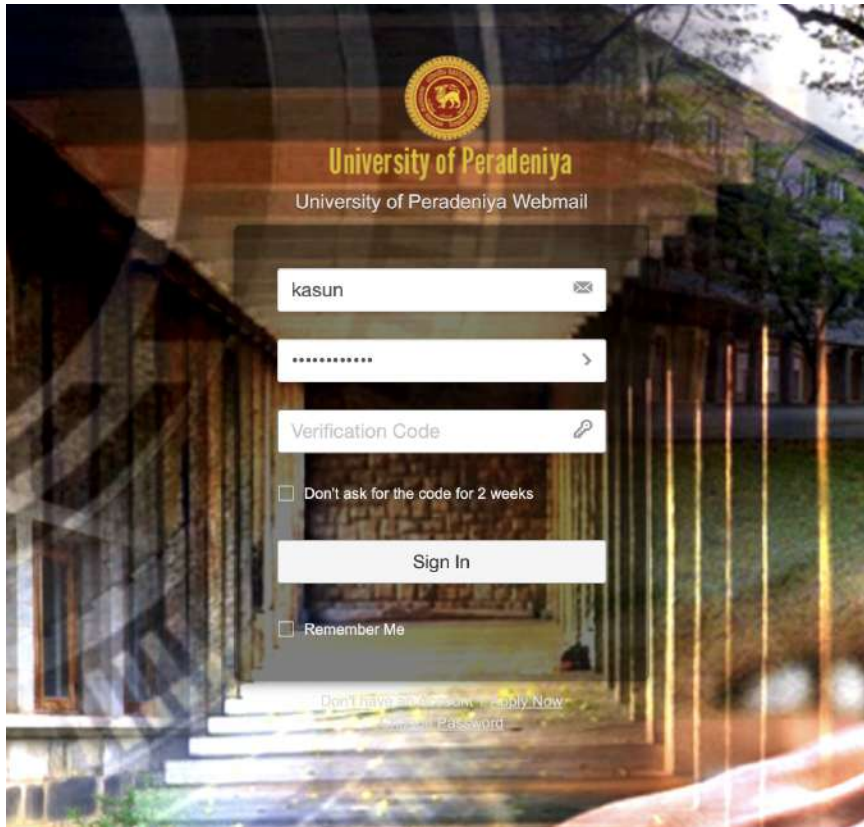
9. Test button color will change to green if the Test is successful. If it changes to red, try again.



10. After the successful test Now you can enable two-factor authentication for your PDN Account. Check Enable 2-step verification and click Done in the bottom right corner.



After enabling two-factor authentication you will be asked to enter Verification code from Google Authenticator each time you try to login.



Conditions

- If you are changing your smartphone make sure to transfer your Google Authenticator accounts to your new smartphone.
- If you lose your Google Authenticator account and use your all 9 backup codes, You have to reset the two-factor authentication for your PDN account.
